The Objectives of WestPride Archives Inc

(Rule 2, WestPride Constitution)

Preamble

WestPride Archives **recognise** the diverse Aboriginal communities who are custodians over the lands upon which we live. We appreciate the histories and identities of Aboriginal LGBTQIA+ people that existed prior to colonisation and acknowledge the impact this ongoing process has had on Indigenous/Queer communities across the continent. We **celebrate** the peoples and communities who extend our stories back into the deep histories of this continent and with whom we, with pride, share a common future, and **acknowledge** the inspiration and work of the original Gay And Lesbian Archives of Western Australia (GALAWA) established in 1998 and to whom WestPride Archives is the successor.

Guiding Objective

I. The guiding objective of WestPride Archives is to recover, collect, preserve, organise, and make accessible materials created by and/or relevant to our communities, lives and experiences as Western Australians who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, asexual and more (LGBTQIA+), and with the broadening range of sexualities and gender and sex identities that are and have been emerging over time, through the realisation of these objectives;

Archives and Collections

- II. To maintain and administer an archival institution housing archival collections and cultural heritage materials relating to our communities and peoples.
- III. To collect as widely as possible to reflect the diversity of experiences and histories of our communities and peoples.
- IV. To encourage, facilitate and deepen understandings of and research into the histories and heritages of our communities and peoples.

Accessibility and Safety

- V. To make the collections accessible to our communities and to the public who have an interest in learning about and developing understandings of the historical and contemporary diversity of our communities.
- VI. To provide safe and welcoming spaces for housing, preserving and accessing the collections that are accessible, physically and virtually, by people of all abilities and backgrounds.

Community and Communities

- VII. To ensure the collections are inclusive of the perspectives and experiences of Indigenous peoples and communities within, or co-existing with, those of our broader communities.
- VIII. To be supported by Western Australia's lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, asexual and more communities as a trustworthy, secure and reliable keeper of their records and artefacts for posterity.
 - IX. To celebrate the cultural richness, social diversity, geographical spread and historical depth of Western Australia's lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex, asexual and more people and communities, and
 - X. To join with other associations and peoples with similar objectives to advance our common interests in Western Australia, Australia and overseas.
